<u>April 23, 2010</u>	Holy Saturday - Solemn Easter Vigil	<i>Easter Triduum</i>	The entire celebration of the vigil takes place at night, beginning after nightfall, and ending before dawn. Sunset for this date in Worcester, Massachusetts is 7:00 PM with nightfall occurring one half hour later; therefore, the Easter Vigil may not begin before 7:30 PM Nine readings are assigned to the Easter Vigil. However, if circumstances demand in individual cases, the number of readings may be reduced. The reading from Exodus 14:15:1 is never omitted. Funeral Mass may not be celebrated Liturgy of the Word with Final Commendation is permitted. Celebration of Marriage is forbidden, as is also the celebration of other sacraments except those of penance and anointing of the sick

<u>May 1, 2011</u>	Octave of Easter	<i>Solemnity</i>	<p>The Congregation for Divine Worship decree (23 May 2000) that “throughout the world, the Second Sunday of Easter will receive the name Divine Mercy Sunday, a perennial invitation to the Christian world to face, with confidence in divine benevolence, the difficulties and trials that human kind will experience in the years to come”</p> <p>The essential celebration consists in the celebration of the liturgy of the Second Sunday of Easter during which the homily should focus in the scriptural readings of the day. It should be noted that the three cycles of readings and the orations are all centered on the forgiveness of sins and God’s infinite mercy.</p>
