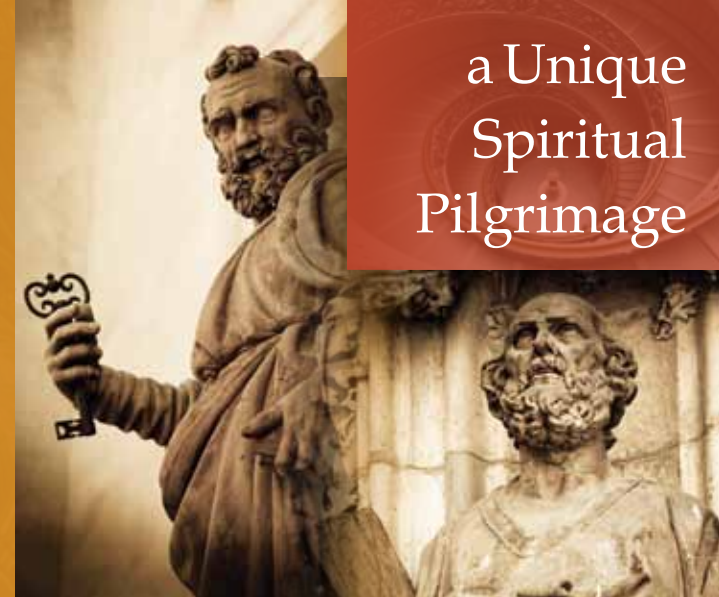

Dinner at Karakol Restaurant, private dining room, on the grounds of the Topkapi Palace.

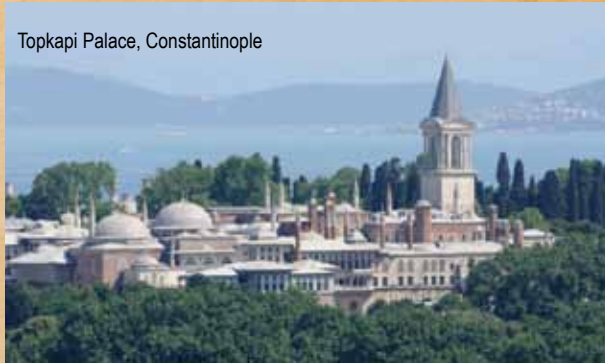
